STRAND 1 OBJECTIVES - ACTIVITIES





DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS

OBJECTIVES

- Improve market readiness and market entry of innovative maritime technologies/services - SMEs
- > Scale up business models and service concepts
- Derisk deployment and reduce funding gaps

ACTIVITIES - full-scale demonstration

- Produce, install, improve, test, validate new materials, products, devices, systems and services, pre-commercial pilots
- Consult, gain feedback and validate the solutions with relevant stakeholders and prepare for full manufacturing and commercialisation

What is at stake?

More **rapid market uptake** of new technologies or industry applications, processes or services across **a sea basin** through **technology demonstration** in **high potential** and **innovative** blue growth domains or value chains.

- ➤ Total budget and co-financing rate: EUR 8 million and 65% co-financing
- ➤ **Grant range per project:** Normally up to EUR 1.000.000, with an absolute maximum of EUR 1.500.000
- Deadline for submission: 28/02/2018

MARINE LITTER

OBJECTIVE

- Develop methodologies and/or technologies to tackle marine litter from sea-based sources in 3 priority areas:
 - reduce its amount and harmfulness
 - monitor and quantify its proportion of marine litter
 - remove and recycle it in environmentally sound and resourceefficient way

- Develop methodology and/or technology
- Evaluate cost-efficiency
- > **Assess** environmental impact







What is at stake?

Tackling marine litter from **sea-based sources**, and contributing to **cleaner seas.**


We expect projects that will develop **strategies and technologies** for reducing, monitoring and quantifying marine litter from sea-based sources or aim at removing and recycling it.

- > Total budget and co-financing rate: EUR 2.000.000; 80%
- Grant range per project: EUR 200.000-500.000
- Deadline for submission: 08/02/2018

BLUE NETWORKS IN THE MED

MAIN OBJECTIVES:

- > Accelerate the **blue economy** in the Mediterranean
- > Through **public-private** collaboration
- Between the EU and its partner countries in the MED
- following 3 specific objectives focusing on SKILLS (education & training), BUSINESS (maritime clusters) and FISHERIES LOCAL COMMUNITIES (in the WESTMED)

It will support skills, innovation, entrepreneurship as well as job diversification and local communities empowerment



STRAND 3 SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE A





SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE A – BLUE NETWORKS IN THE MED

Networking between education and training institutes to develop relevant skills and promote maritime professions in cooperation with business and public authorities.

- Identify needs and joint actions
- Defining common education and training programmes (qualification standards), sharing and pooling resources
- Raising the awareness about and attractiveness of maritime professions including career guidance towards citizens, students and young people



STRAND 3 SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE B





SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE B - BLUE NETWORKS IN THE MED

Networking between maritime clusters for concrete cooperation in terms of maritime innovation and maritime technologies, business development and innovation

- Promoting cooperation between maritime clusters and financial intermediaries
- joint investment in research and innovation, developing cluster strategies, improving cluster management practices
- Strengthening cluster services to business, facilitating access to finance
- Capacity-building and knowledge transfer



STRAND 3 SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE C





SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE C- BLUE NETWORKS IN THE MED

- > Pilot twinning of fisheries local coastal communities
- > Between North and South in the Western Mediterranean

- Establish coastal/fisheries local communities in the Southern partner countries of the western Mediterranean
- ➤ Promote cooperation between local private and public stakeholders, identification of local needs to develop local strategies
- >Strengthen the **participation** of local actors to the governance of local fisheries resources and maritime activities
- > Propose concrete twinning and awareness-raising activities

What is at stake?

Increased **capacity-building** in the Mediterranean for **better education** programmes, better **services to business** and empowerment of **local communities**. We look for **concrete** cooperation projects to boost the blue economy agenda.

- > Total budget and co-financing rate: EUR 3.000.000 80%
- > EU grant range/project: depends on specific objective:
 - A. Education/training: EUR 400.000 500.000
 - B. Clusters: EUR 500.000 700.000
 - C. Local governance: EUR 300.000 400.000
- Number of projects: minimum 1 project per specific objective (and approx 6 projects expected)
- **▶ Deadline for submission: 28/02/2018**

RESTORING MARINE ECOSYSTEMS IN THE MED

OBJECTIVE

- Support restoration of coastal and marine ecosystems in the Mediterranean sea
- In zones with high potential of diverse marine ecosystem services

- > Identify minimum 1 damaged coastal and marine ecosystem
- > **Restore** the area in **innovative** way

> What is at stake?

Contributing to the implementation of actions 6.1. & 6.2 of the Joint Comm. on **international ocean governance and** fund **a project** that will restore **damaged** or **degraded ecosystems** in the MED with high potential to provide marine ecosystem services

- > Total budget and co-financing rate:
 - EUR 1.500.000; 80% co-financing
- > EASME expects to fund **one** project
- **▶ Deadline for submission: 08/02/2018**


