The BLUEMED initiative: objective and process

The BLUEMED Initiative fosters integration of knowledge and efforts of Countries of the MED to jointly create new 'blue' jobs and sustainable growth in the area.

It was a priority of the Programme of the IT Presidency of the Council of the European Union; IT implemented it in close cooperation with CY, HU, FR, GR, MT, SI, ES, PT and BE, and the EU commission (DG RTD, DG MARE).

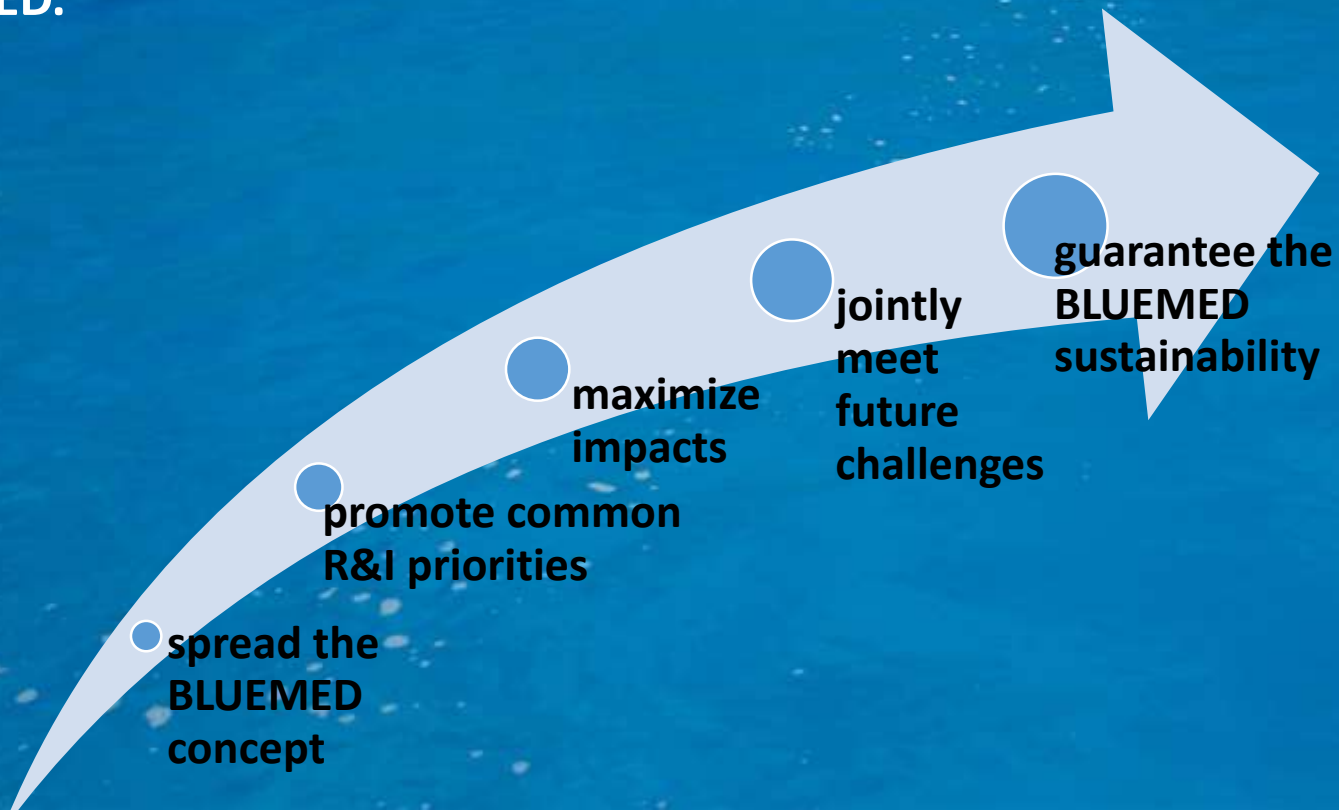

BLUEMED initiative: governance & implementation

The **BLUEMED Strategic Board**, coordinated by IT, DG R&I and DG MARE, joined by Representatives from CY, HR, FR, GR, MT, ES, PT, BE and MNE: **strategic planning**

The **BLUEMED CSA**, coordinated by IT and joined by R&I partners from CY, HR, FR, GR, MT, ES, and PT: **implementation of BLUEMED priorities and strategies in the whole MED.**



BLUEMED implementation: priorities

Facilitate BLUEMED SRIA adoption by each BLUEMED Country in their national plans for Research, Bioeconomy strategies, Regional S3s. Happened in IT, SI, GR, FR, ES;

Engage non-EU MED Countries in the process. Launched with the BLUEMED-UfM event of Sliema (April 2017), the process will be implemented with the “BLUEMED policy dialogue workshop” (1st UfM Regional Stakeholders’ Conference, Naples, Nov 30 2017) and regional meetings of CSA platforms to develop joint actions/R&I agendas.

Promote cooperation among initiatives/actors active in the area, e.g.:

- “EU Strategy for the Adriatic Ionian Region” (EUSAIR) and “Western Mediterranean initiative” (WEST MED), via joint workshops and BLUEMED CSA Platforms;
- CIESM, CIHEAM, CPMR, GFCM, INTERREG MED, UNEP-MAP, Bologna Chapter, etc via the BLUEMED Strategic Board meetings and CSA Platforms;
- major ongoing EU/international projects (R&I, training, education), technology clusters and platforms active in the whole Mediterranean area.....

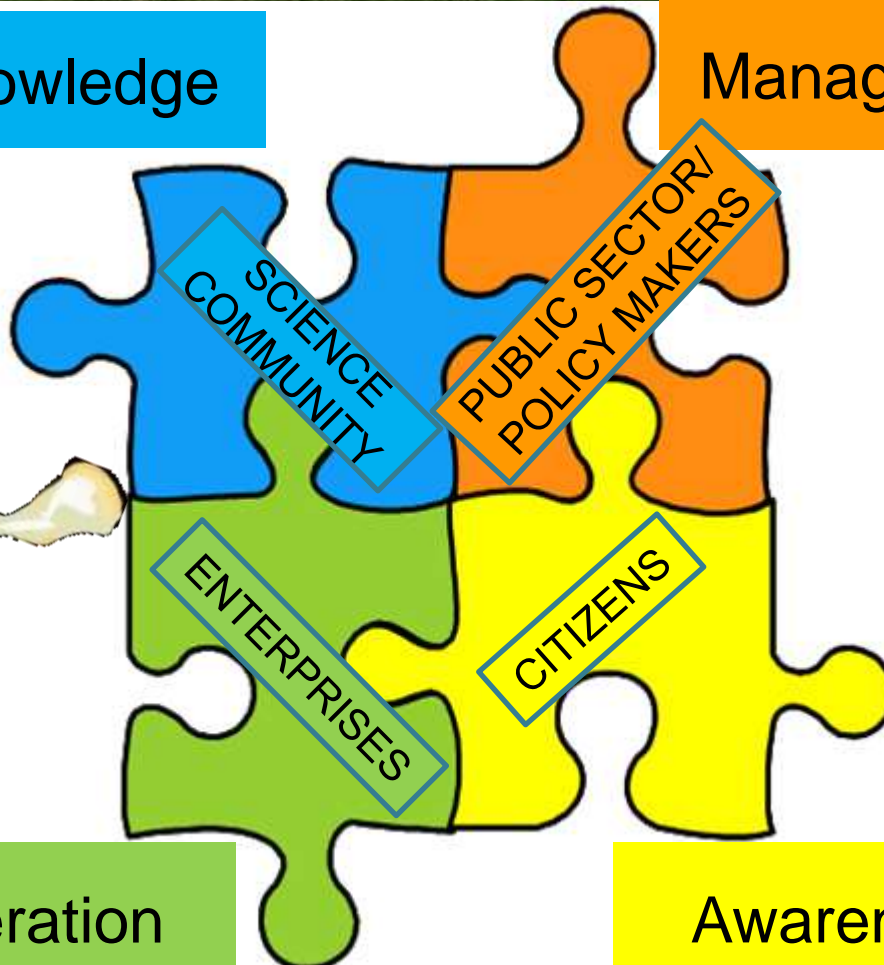
