Agreement for 'Greening' the Ocean Economy

Integrated into EU:

Common fisheries policy (CFP) + Integrated maritime policy (IMP)

Focus areas for Blue Growth:

Spanish 'greening' of the seas: fisheries as backbone of Blue Economy

Basic element for food safety, coastal environmental protection, climate change

8 lines of action:

- 1. Access to finance, especially for SMEs (EMFF, EIB)
- 2. World-class ICT-based control and surveillance system (against IUU)
- 3. Marine protected áreas (10% coastline by 2020)
- 4. Aquaculture / Maritime spatial planning
- 5. Innovation, research-based startups, new business models for Blue Growth
- 6. Centres of excellence of Blue Knowledge
- 7. Intenational cooperation
- 8. Social dimension: training and skills, labour safety, decent working conditions, gender equality.

8 pillars

- 1. Rule of international law (fight against IUU) requires to strengthen control and surveillance systems at national level
- 2. Technology and innovation: centres of excellence as technology platforms enabling technology transfer and finance

- 4. Preservation of eco-systems in marine protected areas
- 5. Innovation is key for future sustainable inclusive competitive growth
- 6. Centres of excellence of Blue Knowledge
- 7. International cooperation: focus on Mediterranean sea
- 8. Social dimension
