

Sustainable Development: Essential Requirements


Development that meets the needs of the present generation without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.

- Protecting and managing the natural resource base.




Sustainable Development in Fisheries?






- Plan







Phase 3. Implementation

 Endorsement of the Plan by the Fisheries Administration.

- Set-up of a Fishery Advisory Committee
- Implement the management recommendations (e.g.)
- Limiting of the fishing licenses and fishing capacity
- Social protection for small scale fishers
- Monitoring, Control and Surveillance (MCS)
- Recreational fisheries

Some general lessons learnt

- Key Players are not only the Fishers!
- Invest on the management authority.
- One shouldn't forget about recreational fisheries especially in coastal areas.
- Participatory approach which is lacking.
- Strengthening communication and to find synergies among stakeholders
- EAF management plans can provide:

clear pathways
traceable targets
development actions
