<u>Abstract</u>

Shifting current consumption and production patterns of economic development to more sustainable ones raises enormous challenges. Yet, these challenges often represent an opportunity for entrepreneurs and startups to build and scale sustainable businesses that not only help overcome the challenge, but can also lead to more fair and sustainable growth. At the Blue Entrepreneurship World Café / Entrepreneurship Lab for a Blue Economy, you will connect in depth and exchange around specific questions to identify compelling challenges and define how entrepreneurship support programmes and organizations (such as SwitchMed – UN Environment/MAP SCP/RAC, Egypreneur and UACTI) can best sustain blue entrepreneurs and start-ups in addressing these challenges.

Objective

In this workshop, we will present the potential of entrepreneurs to contribute to a Blue Economy with real-world examples from entrepreneurs working on environmental challenges. Afterwards, we will have an interactive discussion (using the world café format) to identify activities that can harness this potential most effectively, and match (potential) entrepreneurs to these challenges. In the end, we will ask each table to present an idea based on their discussion in a simple format to everyone, and have short discussions in the group.
