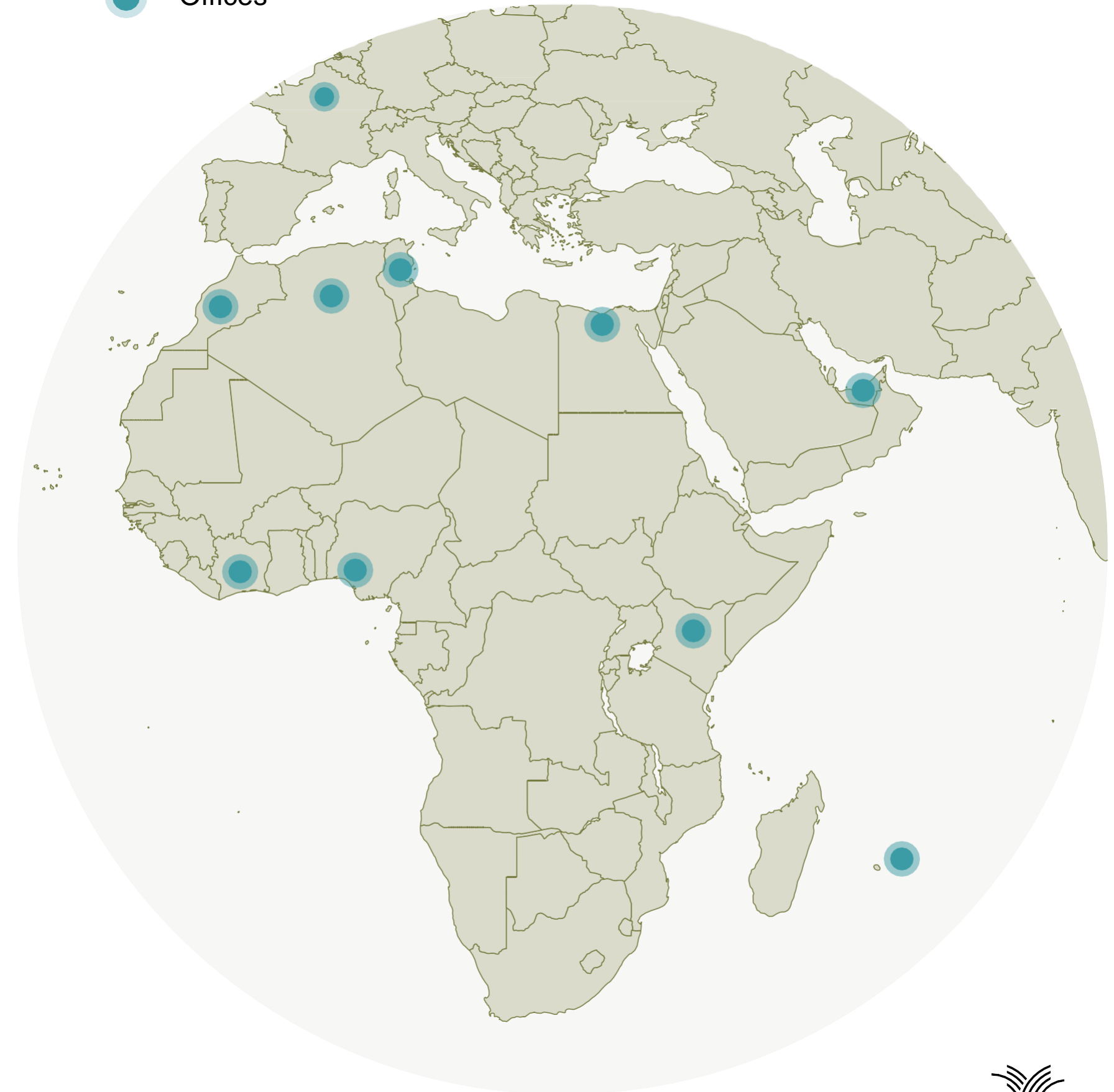

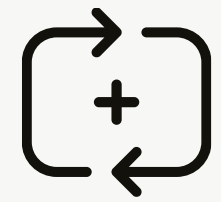

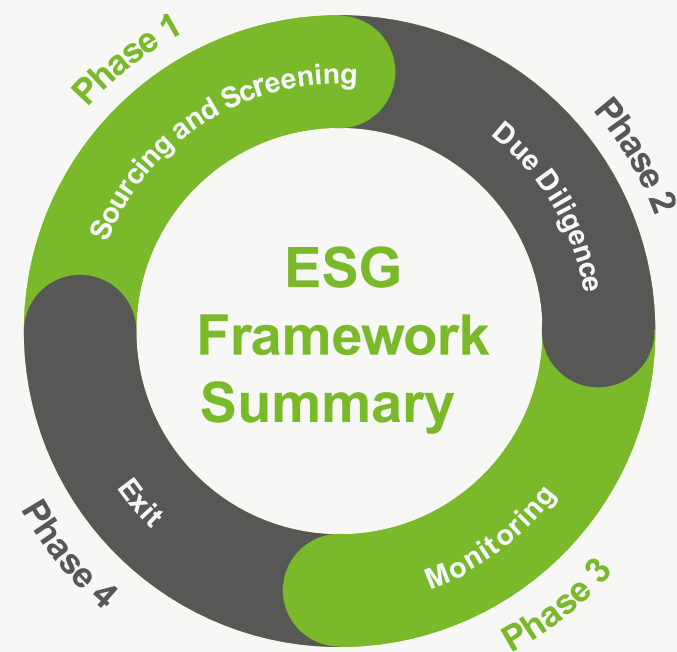

PHASE 1

- Estimation of the carbon footprint of the investment
- Assessment of the physical and transition risks and opportunities

PHASE 2

- Deeper impact due diligence to confirm the theory of change and identify the risks of the impact not materializing
- Integrating value-add initiatives in the E&S action plan

PHASE 4

- Conduct exit assessments to complete a more holistic assessment of the impact created and generate lessons learnt

PHASE 3
