






- Integrated Energy and Climate Plan for Bosnia and Herzegovina until 2030 (NECP BiH)
- ✓ obligation arising from the Energy Community Treaty
- ✓ targets for increasing energy efficiency measures, increasing the use of RES and reducing GHG emissions by 2030, as well as the necessary policies and measures to achieve them
- ✓ first time that BiH applies an integrated approach where the future
 development of energy is observed in accordance with climate change
