Making cooperation happen in the Mediterranean since 2007


- Interreg NEXT MED is the **third edition** of the **largest EU-funded external cooperation** • programme in the Mediterranean Sea Basin programme
- It builds on the experience accumulated by **80 ENI CBC MED** (2014-2020 period) projects ulletand **95 ENPI CBC MED** (2007-2013 period) projects, involving over **1.300 project partners** and over **€400 million** in project funding
- **Blue Economy in ENI CBC MED**: projects in Fisheries, Ports, Logistics, Marine Spaces, ۲ Coastal planning, Coastal Tourism, R&I, Training, etc.
- Contribution to joint prosperity, stability and security by addressing together common ۲ challenges
- Key principles: co-ownership, cooperation on equal footing, balanced partnership, common benefits

Interreg NEXT MED vision and ambition




