### Call 04 thematic focus



Strengthening an innovative sustainable economy

Focus on the development of an innovative and sustainable bio-economy in the Green and Blue economy sectors: use of renewable biological resources from land and sea to produce food, materials, and energy



Protecting, restoring and valorising the natural environment and heritage

Focus on flood prevention, costal resilience, cultural landscapes, biodiversity loss, urban-nonurban connectivity, citizens participation, area-based conservation and restoration, Conservation of species and habitats and connectivity, Green and blue ecosystems in the urban and peri-urban, wetland, water resources



Promoting green living areas

regeneration: heat island effects, water cycle management, integrated renovation of buildings and housing stock. It's less about mitigation than adaptation. Need to integrate the quality-of-life dimension, a holistic approach and citizens participation.



Enhancing sustainable tourism

Focus on **tourism resilience,** regenerative tourism model

# Update on Programme implementation: Call05 Thematic Strategic Territorial projects

# Call open for pre-applications from 18/06/2024 to 26/09/2025

Around 8-10 Projects shall start in spring 2025
Project Duration: 45 months
Project budget: up to 4M€
80% EU contribution – 20% national co-financing

**Co-funded** partners: **from an EU member**-state **or one of the 4 countries** of the Programme cooperation area benefiting from the Instrument of pre-adhesion (Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Montenegro and North Macedonia)

Associated partners: from any country, within or outside of the EU
















# Mission Natural Heritage
