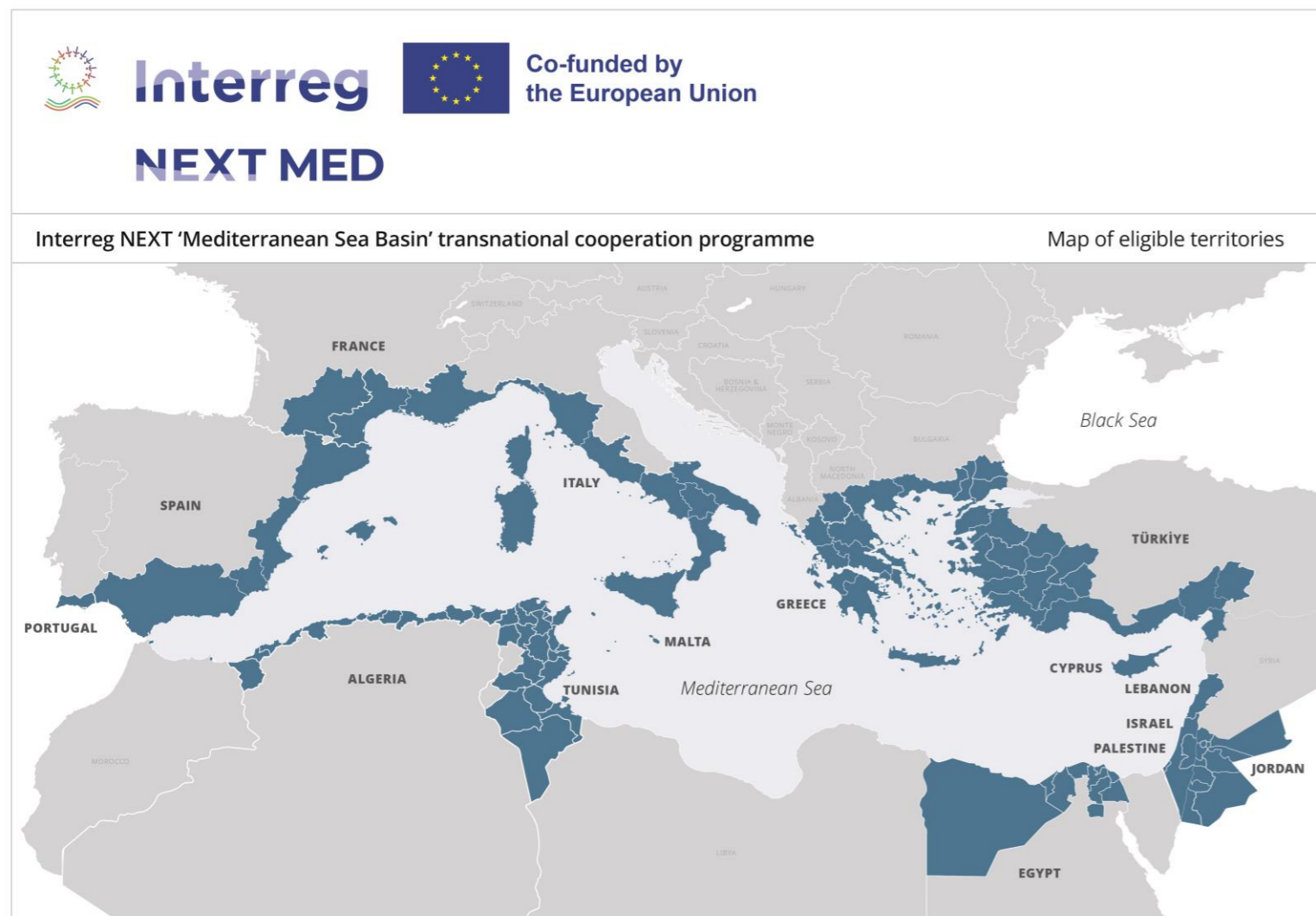

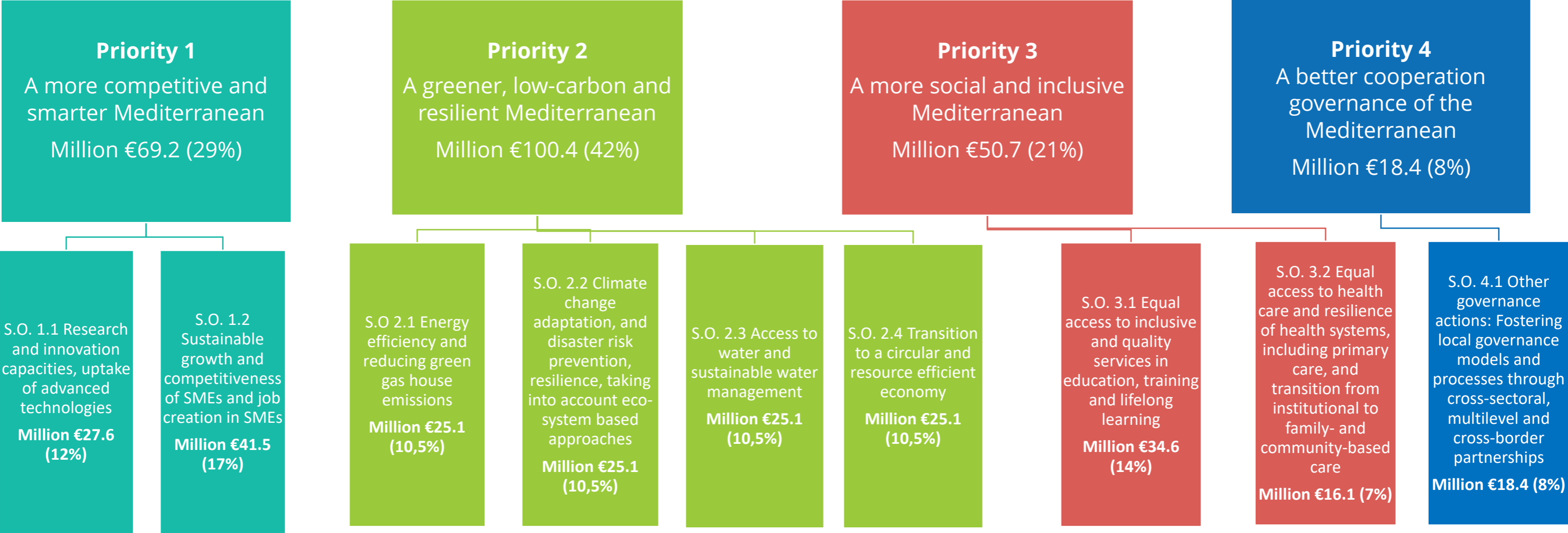

THE FIRST CALL FOR PROPOSALS AT A GLANCE

Key facts and figures

- Opened in **December 2023** and closed in **May 2024**
- **4 Programme Priorities** and **9 Programme Specific Objectives**;
- EU funds allocated: **€ 103.633.273,00** (Specific financial allocation per specific objective);
- **Up to 89%** of projects total costs covered by the EU contribution;
- **Minimum project** contribution **11%** of the total costs;
- **3 types of projects**: Thematic, Youth-oriented and Governance;
- **Minimum 3** participating countries in partnerships;
- **Min 1 Mediterranean Partner Country (MPC)** and **min 1 European Union Member Country (EUMC)** in partnerships.

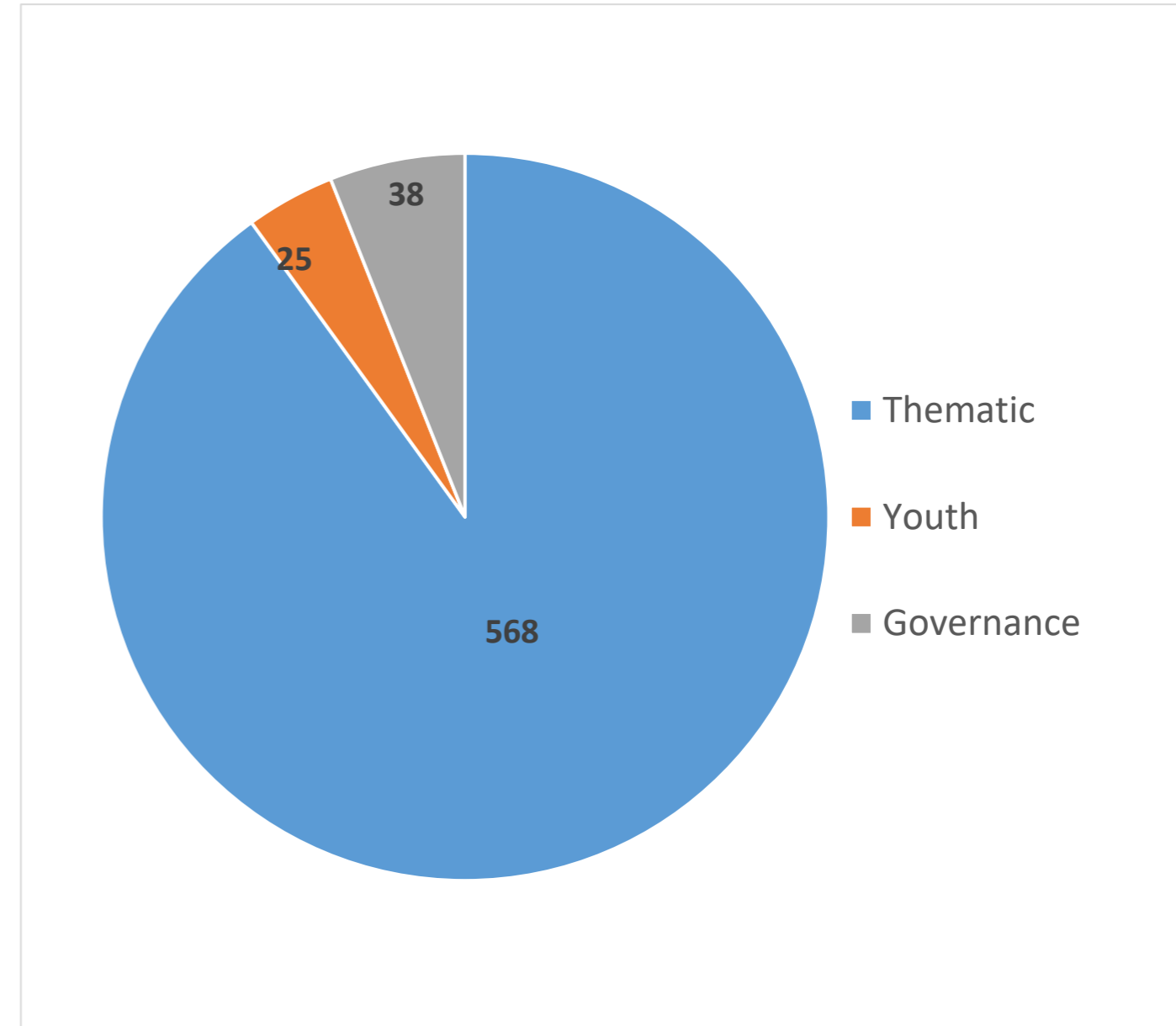
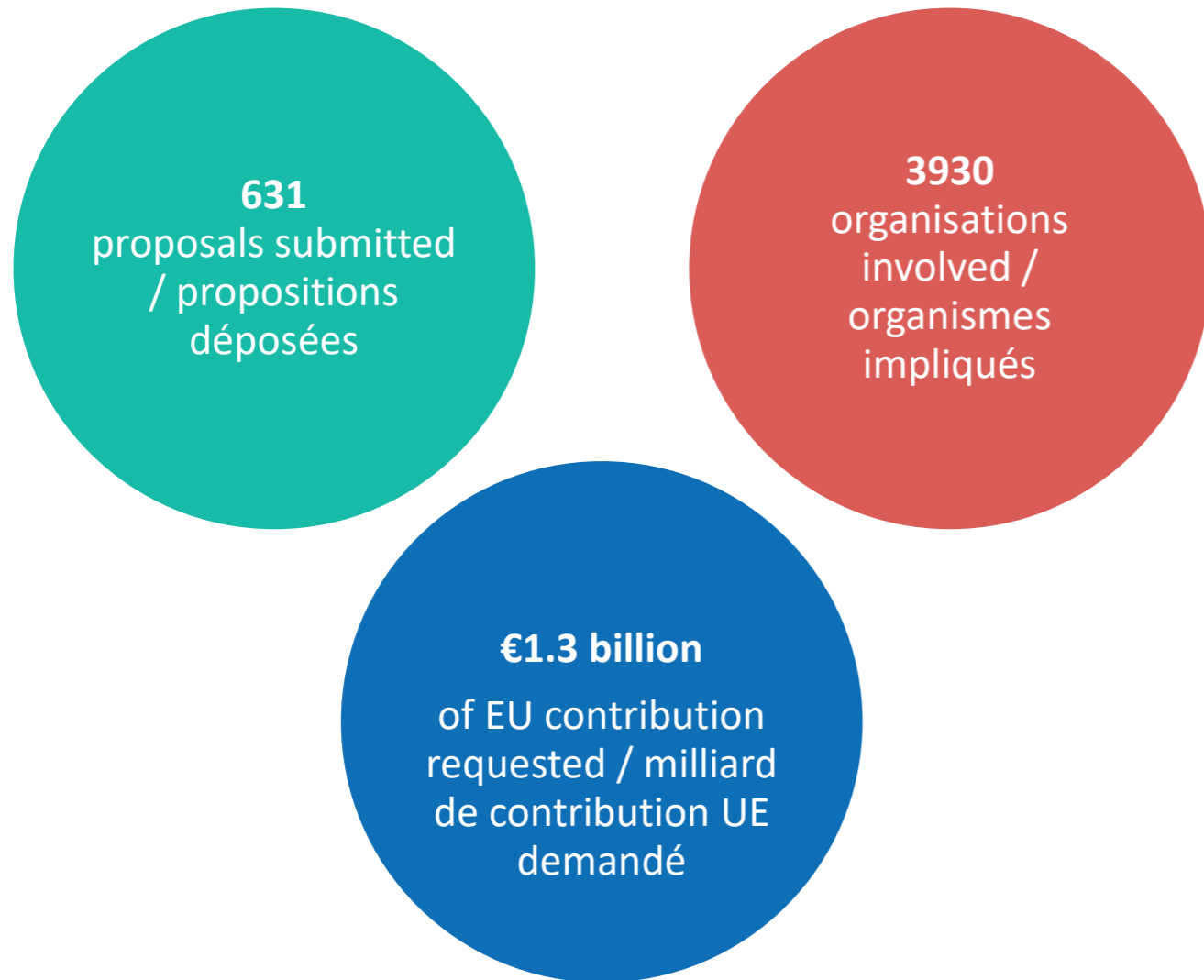

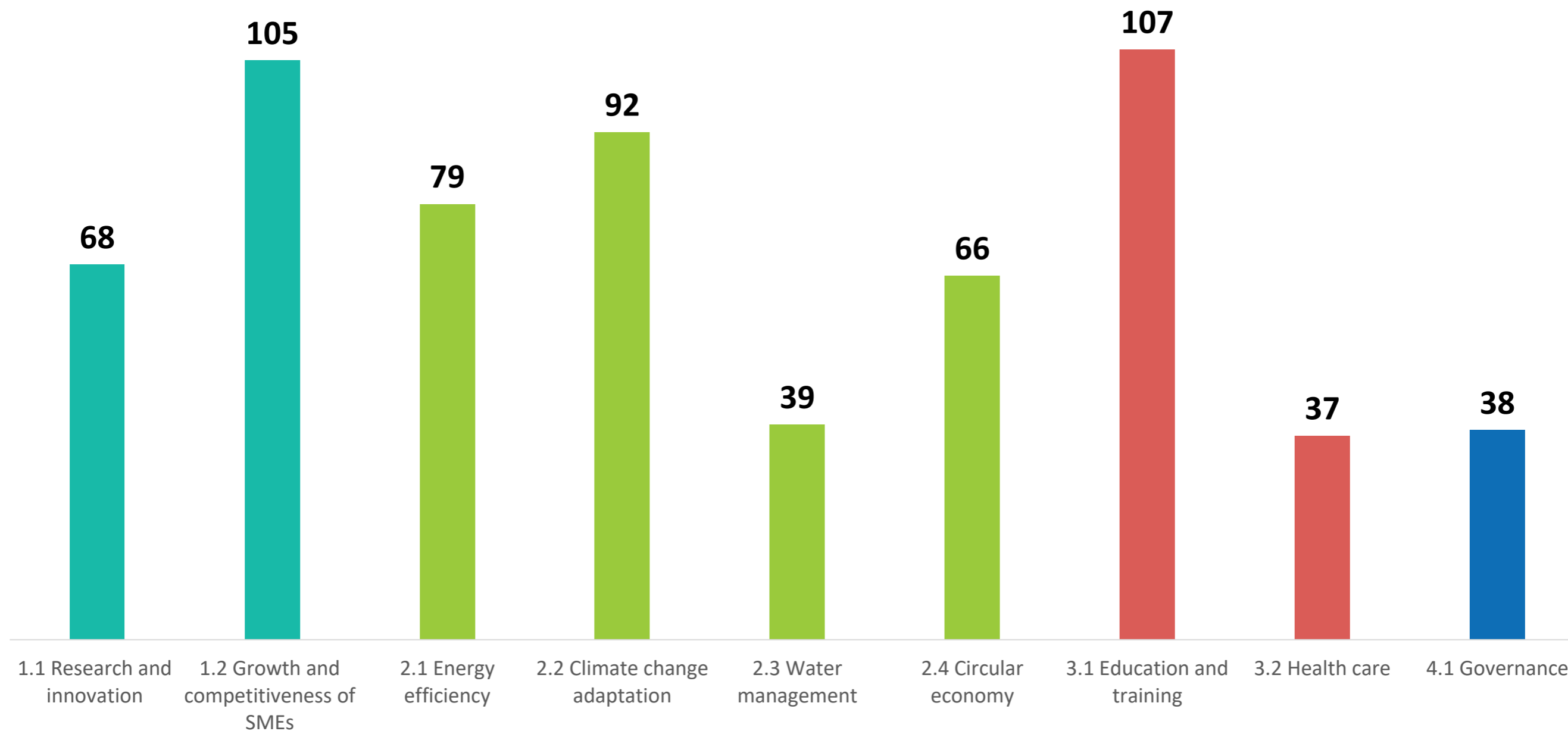

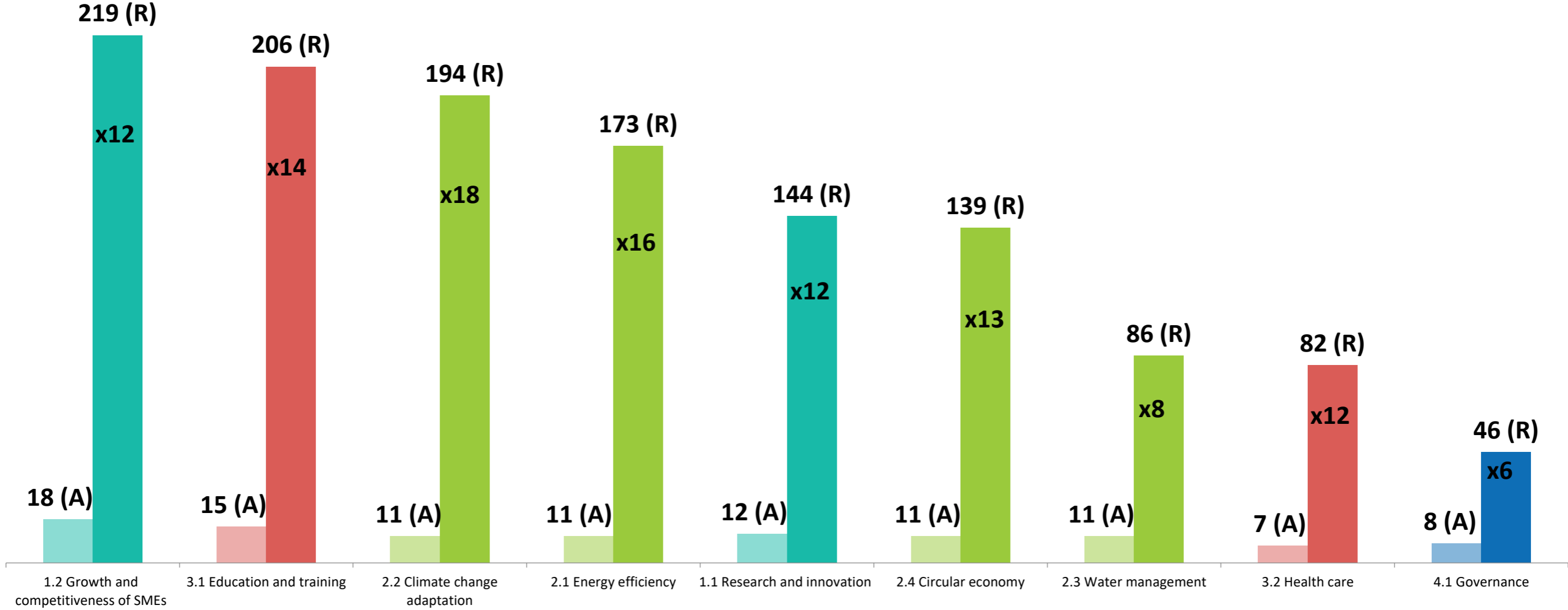

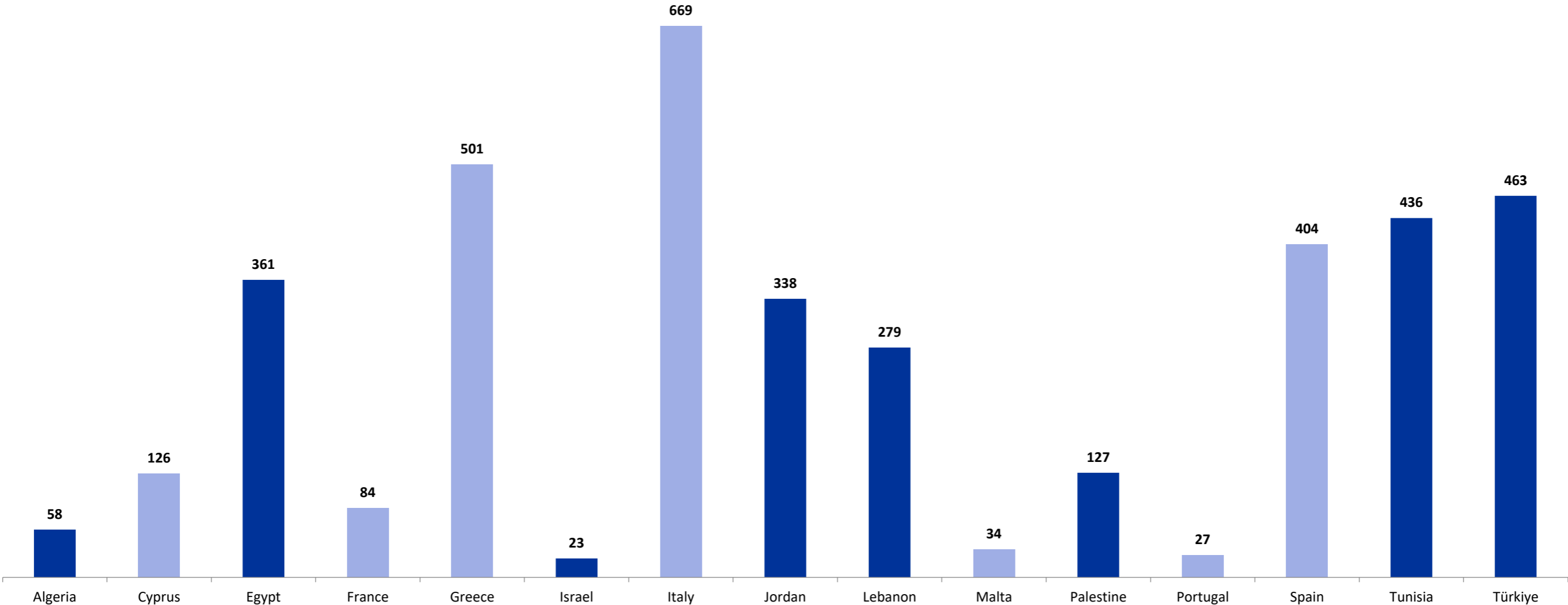

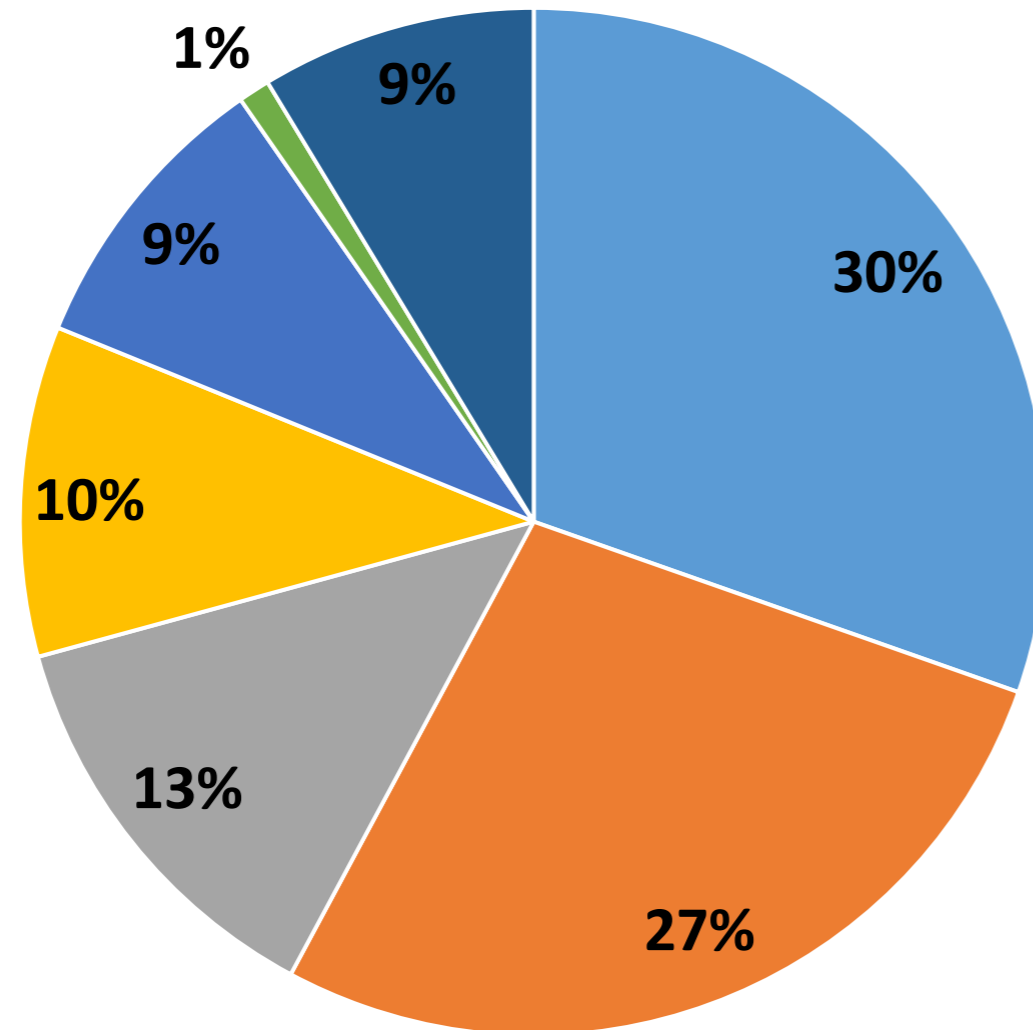

Interreg NEXT MED: Second call for proposals boosting green transition!

- **Preparation of the ToRs for the call on Green Transition:** consultation of stakeholders and adaptation of the indicative actions towards a green transition! *Over 350 feedbacks confirming the interest towards all SOs*
- The **call budget** will be an important element: using the additional allocation towards green! *Proposal to allocate about 90 mil. Euro of EU funds*
- Involvement of the **young generation** remains a priority as well as the **effectiveness** of the projects! *Increasing project budget to boost the number of proposals*
- Monitoring Committee is expected to decide on the main features, evaluation criteria in **mid July** (MC meeting in Athens)
- Expected launch of the second call: **November 2024**
