



Mission work programmes 2021-2022-2023-2024:







WP 2024 - Mission Ocean, seas and waters adopted on 17 April 2024: main features

- WP 2024: 2 calls; 7 topics + 4 other actions; indicative budget EUR 127 million
 - Call 1 includes thematic topics following the Mission objectives (Protection and restoration; Pollution prevention and elimination; Blue Economy sustainability)
 - Call 2 includes topics directed at supporting communities of actors (e.g.: waterfront cities, islands, ports, coastal regions)
 - Other actions focus on: DTO; monitoring Mission policy objectives; events; specific studies





HORIZON-MISS-2024-OCEAN-01-01 European Blue Parks – Offshore marine protected areas



Scope: Map the distribution and condition of benthic and pelagic habitats in offshore areas (> 12 nautical miles); assess pressures; provide scientific basis for conservation measures/establishing/enlarging MPAs in offshore areas **Innovation Action** – EUR 11.1 million – 1 project expected to be funded





HORIZON-MISS-2024-OCEAN-01-03

→ Atlantic and Arctic – Mediterranean – Baltic and North se basin lighthouses



Scope:

 test and demonstrate mitigation measures, sustainable fishing tools (e.g. : innovative gears, techniques to improve selectivity/bycatches) and sustainable fishing operations (e.g.: restricted areas, temporal/special closures, safe handling of bycaught species, experimental restocking);

- assess of the operational feasibility in commercial fishery situations and support broad uptake of solutions

Each proposal should address one sea basin i.e.: Atlantic and Arctic basin; Mediterranean sea basin, Baltic and North Sea basin – Demos in at least 3 MS/ACs

Innovation Action – EUR 24 million – 3 projects expected to be funded (one per sea basin)





HORIZON-MISS-2024-OCEAN-01-04

Science for Community – Building the Marine Citizen Science data network of the future to valorise data from the ocean and increase engagement



Scope: Three groups of activities \rightarrow

- Establish a Marine Citizen Science network, bringing together relevant actors active in citizen science and data collection;
- Information and data collection, making them FAIR (findable, accessible, interoperable and reusable) and integrated in existing platforms (e.g.: EMODnet, Blue Economy Observatory, etc.) and eventually available for use in the European Digital Twin Ocean;
- Support the deployment of **cost-efficient and simple-to-use citizen science devices/equipment** (two use-cases)

Coordination and Support Action – EUR 2 million – 1 project expected to be funded





HORIZON-MISS-2024-OCEAN-01-05

Our Blue Future – Co-designing a future vision of a restored ocean and water system in the EU by 2030 and 2050



Scope: Develop scenarios and a vision for EU ocean and waters for 2030 and 2050 based on participatory approaches.

A pan-European and specific vision for the four Mission lighthouse basins are expected (e.g.: "*what if*" in business as usual versus a Mission target achieved scenarios).

Interactive and digital visualisation tools and application are expected.

Innovation Action – EUR 3 million – 1 project expected to be funded





HORIZON-MISS-2024-OCEAN-02-01

Community-led actions to restore our ocean, seas and waters



Scope: Support the uptake of innovative solutions, measures and initiatives contributing to the Mission's objectives.

Research and Innovation Action – EUR 50 million – 4 projects expected to be funded (one per basin lighthouse) + cascade grants)

→ Cascade grants for community-led actions (EUR 0,2 to 2 million each) and for transition agendas (up to EUR 100.000 each) e.g.: R&I activities to validate/demonstrate solutions; feasibility studies, business plans...

→ Provision of Technical assistance





HORIZON-MISS-2024-OCEAN-02-02 Support for the Coalition of waterfront cities, regions and islands for

Mission Ocean and Waters



Scope: promote a coalition of Mission important actors to support coordination, networking, twinning, share of good practices to achieve the Mission objectives

Coordination and Support Action – EUR 4 million – 1 project expected to be funded





What are associated regions?

- areas with ecosystems that can benefit from the demonstration activities

 (e.g., neighbouring regions and/or regions in a different sea basin) and/or less-developed regions, with the need to build capacity to implement the
 innovative solutions to restore marine/freshwater ecosystems.
- associated regions should be located in Member States/Associated countries, and not be already involved in the demonstration sites covered by the projects.





How do associated regions work?

- Calls for Associated regions organised by relevant projects, with an evaluation based on transparent and fair procedures
- Financial support to third parties:
 - may only be awarded to local and/or regional authorities from an associated region.
 - the maximum amount to be granted to each associated region is EUR 100,000
- Projects should continuously share their outcomes and knowledge with the 'associated regions' and provide them with technical assistance to build capacity and to implement solutions in their territory that contribute to achieving the Mission objectives.


