

Meetings of the <u>UfM Regional Platform on Transport Connectivity and</u> <u>its thematic Working Groups</u> (Brussels, 3-4 October 2023)

- Assess the progress made so far in the regional transport cooperation and identify challenges that have emerged.
- Discuss our priorities moving forward in light of the implementation of the new RTAP 2021-2027 and the Ministerial Declaration endorsed on 9 February 2023.
- The meeting of the WG on Maritime Transport also offered the possibility to reflect on how to maximise the benefits of SAFEMED V.
- The WGs also served as a platform for initial discussions on monitoring and evaluation, laying the groundwork for the mid-term review of the RTAP foreseen by the end of 2024.
- The next round of meetings of the Regional Platform and its WGs have will be held in Barcelona (UfMS HQ) on 27-28 November 2024.

RTAP Priorities on Sustainable Ports and Maritime Transport

- 1. Greening of ports and shipping and protection of marine environment through regulatory reforms and accession to/implementation of international agreements
- 2. Emissions reduction measures in ports and maritime transport (exchange of best practices)
- 3. Environmental management plans for ports
- 4. Ports as sustainable energy hubs
- 5. Development of maritime transport through the Motorways of the Sea concept

- **Technological Aspects for Greening Maritime Shipping:** Assessing the feasibility and scalability of emerging technologies such as alternative fuels, energy-efficient propulsion systems, and renewable energy integration for ships operating in the Mediterranean.
- Infrastructure Development: Discussing the infrastructure requirements for supporting sustainable maritime transportation, including shore power facilities, bunkering stations, decarbonization of ports, and port upgrades.
- Economic and Social Implications: Analyzing the economic costs and benefits of decarbonization measures for various stakeholders, as well as their social implications for maritime communities.
- **Cross-Sectoral Collaboration:** Exploring opportunities for collaboration between the maritime industry, energy sector, research institutions, and governments to accelerate decarbonization efforts.

 - Collaboration with port authorities, shipping companies, logistics operators.

- 2. Activities/initiatives promoted by the UfM Secretariat
 - Different formats:
 - Regional dialogue and cooperation
 - Technical assistance and capacity building (RTAP implementation)
 - Awareness raising / communication campaigns.
 - Adhering to / supporting on-going initiatives and projects or proposing new ones (UfM label, visibility and political endorsement)
 - Financial facilitator with IFIs and donors
