# THE CALL FOR GREEN TRANSITION PROJECTS AT A GLANCE

# Key facts and figures

- Open to the 4 Programme Priorities and 9 Programme Specific Objectives;
- EU funds allocated: **€ 83,7 million**;
- **Up to 89%** of projects costs covered by the EU contribution;
- Specific financial allocation per specific objective;
- 2 types of projects: Green Transformation projects & Eco-youth projects
- Minimum 3 participating countries in partnerships;
- Minimum 1 Mediterranean Partner Country and min 1 European Union Mediterranean Country in partnerships.

A proposal shall refer to one Specific Objective only!













Financial dimension and duration

**Green Transformation** and **Eco-youth** projects are open to the 9 specific objectives including Governance (New!)
















Financial allocation by Programme Specific Objective

#### Blue Economy – Where does it stands? (Non-exhaustive sectors)

**Blue Economy** and **blue Jobs** are transversal sectors in several Programme Specific Objectives:

- ✓ Innovation and uptake of advanced technologies (S.O. 1.1)
- ✓ Competitiveness of SMEs (S.O. 1.2)
- ✓ Training and education (S.O. 1.3)

Sustainable Tourism, Aquaculture, Fisheries, Biodiversity & Ecosystems are potential sectors in:

- ✓ Energy Efficiency (S.O. 2.1)
- ✓ Climate change adaptation (S.O 2.2)
- ✓ Water Management (S.O 2.3)
- ✓ Circular Economy (S-O 2.4)

# **Eco-youth projects**

- Can be submitted under all specific objectives;
- Aim to **enable young people to take action** in Interreg NEXT MED Programme through their participation in the design and implementation of the projects;
- All proposals shall have the scope to **deliver exclusively for young people**;
- Will **meet at least one of the two** following criteria:

Partnership including at least
2 organisations whose
majority of staff involved in
the management is aged 18-30

And / Or Partnership including at least2 organisations whose coremission\* is to work for thebenefit of young people

# Eligibility of territories

#### 15 countries participating in the Programme:

**EUMCs:** Cyprus, France, Greece, Italy, Malta, Portugal, Spain

MPCs: Algeria, Egypt, Jordan, Israel, Lebanon, Palestine, Tunisia, Türkiye

#### **General rules (par. 4.3.1):**

- Applicants and Partners **must be located in <u>eligible territories</u>** of these countries ONLY (**max. 2** from the **same country**);
- New! Exception: Advisory partners. Maximum 1 partner per project that can be from non-eligible regions of participating countries (ex: Alentejo, Lombardia, Aragon, Aquitaine, Constantine, etc.). Only if justified by the added-value for the eligible regions with activities to be implemented in eligible regions only.











#### THE FIRST CALL FOR PROPOSALS

### Eligibility of Applicants and partners

Participation is allowed for legal entities (not physical persons) with <u>legal status</u> of:

- Public bodies (national and local administrations, other public bodies);
- Bodies governed by public law\*;
- **Private Bodies** (enterprises, NGOs, associations and other no profit organisations, etc.):
- International Organisations with limitations (see slide 14 and par. 4.4 of the Guidelines for Applicants) set up by intergovernmental agreements and accepting specific programme obligations through a specific declaration to be submitted.

The applicant and the partners shall be **legally registered** in the **eligible territories** since **at least two years from the launching date of this first call**!













#### THE FIRST CALL FOR PROPOSALS

### Specific requirements

#### Conditions to be met:

- The same organisation can apply **only once as Applicant under each Specific Objective**;
- No limitation applies for the participation at partner level;
- An Applicant cannot be awarded\* more than 2 grants as Lead Partner under this call for proposals.

In case an organisation participates in more than one 1 project as Applicant under the same Specific Objective, all concerned projects submitted under that Specific Objective will be rejected!
