

#### **EVALUATION BACKGROUND**

## 2020 Online Consultation with countries and Stakeholders on the 2015 UfM Ministerial Declaration on Blue Economy

- ✓ Provided strategic insights into the role of the Ministerial Declaration for creating a joint framework of action in the Mediterranean region
- ✓ Highlighted the need for a more concrete roadmap and monitoring system
- ✓ Insights and learnings were used to develop the 2nd UfM Ministerial Declaration on Sustainable Blue Economy



#### 2021 UfM Ministerial Declaration on Sustainable Blue Economy



#### 10 key priorities:

- ✓ Governance and the future of sea basin strategies in the Mediterranean region
- ✓ Marine research and innovation, skills, careers and employment
- ✓ Sustainable food from the Sea: fisheries and aquaculture
- ✓ Sustainable, climate-neutral and zero-pollution maritime transport and ports
- ✓ Interactions between marine litter and the blue economy
- ✓ Coastal and maritime tourism
- Maritime Spatial Planning and IntegratedCoastal Zone Management
- ✓ Marine renewable energies
- Maritime safety and security of blue economy activities
- √ Sustainable investments in the blue economy

#### **EVALUATION PURPOSE**

Assessing the past and looking at the future

- ✓ Carry out an external evaluation of the 2021 UfM Ministerial Declaration on Sustainable Blue Economy, focusing on the implementation of the 10 priorities
- ✓ Assessing implementation period 2021-2024, looking at main achievements, challenges and gaps
- ✓ Developing recommendations regarding any finetuning of thematic priorities and related key actions, as well as on the monitoring framework and reporting system and operational coordination mechanism
- ✓ Useful inputs for future political deliberations

#### **EVALUATION PROCESS - STEPS**




- ✓ Time frame: January-July 2025
- ✓ Carried out by a team of independent consultants contracted by UfM through a public procurement
- ✓ Data collection through mixed methods incl. document review, interviews with selected country focal points and regional stakeholders, and direct observation through participation in relevant events, such as UfM Regional Platform on Sustainable Blue Economy
